Introduction

Young people must meet certain criteria to participate on the Whitgift SNAP Project. Whitgift SNAP reserves the right to update this policy at any time and without notice. Every effort will be made to inform those involved, but SNAP recognises that this is not always possible/practical.

Criteria

To participate on the SNAP Project young people must:

1. be between 5 and 25 years of age (inclusive), and
2. reside in the London Borough of Croydon, and
3. not live in full time residential care, and
4. have a recognised medical diagnosis, which involves physical and/or learning disabilities.

Allocations

- Young people who fulfil the enrolment criteria will be allowed no fewer than 3 days on the Crocodile Scheme (5 – 18 years) or the Alligator Scheme (18 – 25 years)
- Except in exceptional circumstances, no young person will be allocated more than 5 days on the Project

All applications received prior to the deadline will be allocated a place on the relevant Scheme.

Applications received after the deadline will be placed on a waiting list and contacted should a place become available.
